New Law Began April 7th

If You Use Your Windshield Wipers, You Must Use Your Headlights The new Massachusetts law began April 7.

Massachusetts drivers will be required to turn on their headlights whenever they turn on their windshield wipers, effective April 7. The Massachusetts legislature passed the new law - M.G.L.c.85, sec 15 - in December 2014.

Basically, if you need your wipers, you must use your headlights, even on a sunny, but rainy day. Under the law, a police officer can pull you over for failing to comply. The police officer also can issue a ticket for failure to compile with the new Massachusetts headlight law.

From the Board of Assessors:

This year, as it does every year, The Board of Assessors will be sending an Income and Expense form to owners of commercial and industrial properties and larger apartment buildings. The format is unchanged from previous years.

It is important for property owners to understand that the Board is interested in knowing income and expense information that relates to the operation of the real estate only. Financial information unrelated to the property is of no interest to the Board. The Board will use this information to help establish local rental & expense market conditions for calendar

years 2013 and 2014 for FY2015 valuations. This data is kept strictly confidential and utilized solely for the purpose of generating assessments for these classes of properties. For those properties that don't have rental information such as owner occupied properties, expense information, as requested in the form should be included.

The Board of Assessors would like to once again thank the Chelmsford Business Association for the opportunity to discuss the content and submission of the Income and Expense forms in this Newsletter.


